

## **Pre-Kindergarten Supply List (2010-2011)**

- 12 – #2 Dixon-Ticonderoga pencils (sharpened)
- 1 – box of Crayola washable (if possible) crayons (96 count)
- 1 – box of Crayola washable markers (classic colors)-please leave in the box
- 1 – pkg. of washable clear glue sticks (6 count)
- 1 – pkg. of play-dough, any colors (4 count)
- 1 – pair of Fiskars soft grip scissors for kids, rounded tip \*
- 1 – set of Prang watercolors \*
- 1 – pkg. of 9x12 construction paper (color will be assigned at the Parent Orientation Meeting)
- 1 – pkg. of 12x18 construction paper (color will be assigned at the Parent Orientation Meeting)
- 1 – pkg. of 9x12 watercolor paper (GIRLS ONLY)
- 1 – yellow vinyl pocket folder, with or without brads (for PIF – Parent Information Folder) \* (see instructions)
- 1 – white, 2 inch 3-ring binder w/ a clear plastic cover on the front and side (for portfolios)
- 2 – pkgs. heavy weight sheet protectors (50 count each) – You can find these @ Wal-Mart.
- 1 – pkg. of copy paper for journals – white (BOYS ONLY)
- 1 – roll of paper towels 2 – pkg. of Clorox/Lysol wipes (for cleaning)
- 1 – box of (Kleenex) tissues
- 1 – pkg. of antibacterial hand wipes or baby wipes (GIRLS ONLY)
- 1 – bottle of hand sanitizer w/ a pump (BOYS ONLY)
- 1 – pkg. of clear, 8 oz. plastic cups
- 2 – boxes of gallon Ziploc bags
- 2 – boxes of quart Ziploc bags
- 1 – box of snack-sized Ziploc bags – GIRLS ONLY
- 1 – pkg. of small paper plates – BOYS ONLY
- \*1 – vinyl rest mat, small pillow, and blanket (These will be kept at school until the end of the year.)
- \* 1 – backpack (no characters, please) – (It needs to be large enough to hold 9x12 items and the PIF folder easily.)
- \* 1 – lunchbox (no characters, please) – (It needs to have a handle or a strap for easy carry.)
- \* 1 – pair of All WHITE shoes —Velcro preferred
- 1 – no-tie shoe strings must be purchased if you cannot find Velcro shoes (look @ the Shoe Carnival)
- \*1 – change of clothes, appropriate to the season (These must also comply with Veritas school uniform policies.)
- \* 1 – coat (appropriate to the season) & optional Veritas jacket or sweater for the classroom (must have the logo on it)
- 1 – Primary Handwriting Tablets (horizontal pages) – use at home for extra practice
- 1 – 1 inch, 3-ring binder for parents (to be kept @ home to collect all classroom communications) - optional  
(Parent Orientation materials, assignment sheets, etc.)

# **Kindergarten Supply List 2010-2011**

## **Items to be returned at year-end:**

- 1 pair of Fiskar soft grip scissors for kids, rounded tip with student’s name
- 1 sleeping mat or beach towel – **NO CHARACTERS PLEASE**
- 1 backpack – **NO CHARACTERS PLEASE** – with student’s name on the front and full size
- 1 dry erase board with the student’s name on the back
- 1 dry eraser and 2 “low odor” dry erase markers in a large Ziploc baggie with student’s name (some of these may not come back if we use them in class and they dry out)
- 1 extra set of clothes in a large baggie with name (Shirt needs to be collared but does not have to have the crest. Pants can be any khaki pants.)
- White shoes – please use Velcro if your child can not tie their own shoes. I personally do not like the twisty shoe strings. The children have tremendous trouble getting the shoes on their feet with these shoe strings. Velcro is preferred.

## **Items that will NOT be returned at year-end (consumables – please do not label)**

- 12 **sharpened** #2 pencils
- 1 box of crayola brand washable markers 8 count (please buy classic colors only)
- 1 box of crayola crayons (16 or 24 count)
- 6 washable glue sticks
- 1 pkg of normal sized, multi-colored construction paper (around 96 sheets)
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 container of Clorox or Lysol cleaning wipes for the surfaces
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer with pump – **GIRLS ONLY**
- 1 package of hand wipes (baby wipes work great) - **BOYS ONLY**
- 1 box of tissues

- 4 glue sticks
- 1 bottle of glue
- 1 pair of soft grip scissors for kids, rounded tip
- 1 yellow vinyl folder with pockets (for PIF)
- 1 1-1/2" white 3 ring binder for Bible
- 3 dividers with tabs for Bible curriculum
- 1 backpack (no characters please)
- 1 lunchbox (no characters please)
- 1 pkg. disinfectant wipes and 1 roll of paper towels (GIRLS ONLY)

*Heavy plastic magazine holder at Mardel (any color and may decorate)*

Sturdy box with lid for supplies -shoebox size

Plastic box pencil holder (to fit in supply box)

Backpack, sturdy, wheels are good!

1 One inch three-ring binder with pockets-green (for History)

Large zipper pencil bag with 3 holes to hold History cards

1 One inch binder-white (for Shurley English)

2 **plastic** folders with pockets (blue-math, yellow-PIF)

1 package of wide ruled loose-leaf notebook paper (bring unopened)

1 package of dividers (Shurley English-labeled REFERENCES, JINGLES, WRITING and History-WORKSHEETS, MAPS, COMPLETED)

1 composition book- wide ruled, any color! (1<sup>st</sup> half journal, 2<sup>nd</sup> half Bible)

24 #2 pencils

2 red pencils (for checking)

24 count crayons (or whatever is on sale!)

2 boxes 12 count colored pencils (one for home, one for school)

Washable markers are optional

2 12" rulers, with inch and centimeter markings (one for home, one for school)

## Third Grade Supply List (2010-2011)

- Backpack with wheels (1)
- Large pink eraser (1)
- 200 count, wide ruled paper (2) (packages, please, no notebooks)
- medium, plastic, 3-holed zipper pencil pouch (1) (for pencils, dry erase markers and large eraser).
- Small 3-ring binder (1) (Put 1 package notebook paper into this binder, along with the pencil pouch. This will stay at school. Send the other package to school, unopened)
- Large, plastic, zipper pencil pouch (2) (to be used to store Bible and History cards)
- Black composition notebook-50pgs (2) (one is for Science, the other is for SWR)
- 12 count colored pencils (1)
- 10 count washable markers (1)
- Small pencil sharpener with catcher for shavings. (1)
- Red pencils (2)
- Mechanical pencils w/container of lead for refills (I prefer the students to use mechanical pencils to cut back on the need for pencil sharpening and the possibility of dumping shavings on our floor. The pencil sharpener is for the colored pencils only.)
- Pair of small, pointed, scissors (1)
- Dry erase markers, fine point, low odor (4) (Colors are fine, but black and red are necessary.)
- Small dry erase board (1) (white, no lines; approx. 9"x12")
- Dry erase eraser (1) (or old sock)
- Small glue sticks (3)
- 12-inch bendable ruler (1) (with inch, centimeter, and millimeter markings.)
- Protractor
- Shoebox size plastic storage container (1) (For all school supplies that are not in zipper pouch)
- 150 pkg. 3x5 ruled index cards (1)
- Roll paper towels (1)

- 1 - highlighter (any color)
- 3 - sharpened pencils (bring every day—buy 24)
- 2 - Pink Pearl eraser (or a similar eraser)

- 1 - box 8 or 10-count markers, thick (whichever brand you prefer)
- 1 - box 12-count colored pencils, (sharpened)
